

VISA APPLICATION PROCESS

Applicants must submit applications through the official Thai E-Visa official website:
<https://thaievisa.go.th/>

Key Application Steps

- **Create an Account:** Register and activate an account - <https://thaievisa.go.th/signup>
- **Complete the Application Form:** Select the correct visa type (most tourists use the 60-day Tourist Visa) and complete the form.
- **Upload Supporting Documents:** Submit documents including passport photo, flight itinerary, hotel booking, and bank statements.
- **Pay Visa Fee:** Pay the visa fee securely online (approximately \$40 or equivalent).
- **Processing Time:** Generally, takes approximately 5–10 working days, though it is recommended to apply 4-6 weeks before the trip.
- **Receive e-Visa:** The approved visa is emailed to you, which you must print and present at the border

Required Documents

- **Passport:** Valid for at least 6 months
- **Photo:** Recent passport-sized photo (4x6cm)
- **Proof of Travel:** Confirmed round-trip flight tickets
- **Accommodation:** Hotel booking or invitation letter
- **Financial Proof:** Bank statement indicating at least \$700 (or roughly 20,000 THB)
- **Additional:** Travel history and proof of employment may be requested.

Steps for Application (E-Visa)

1. Register on the official e-Visa website: [online eVisa system](#)
2. Fill in personal and travel details.
3. Upload the required documents, ensuring they are clear and in PDF or JPEG format (under 3MB).
4. Pay the visa fee online.
5. Receive the eVisa via email, which must be printed and presented upon arrival.

IMPORTANT NOTICE

All non-Thai nationals entering Thailand must complete the Thailand Digital Arrival Card (TDAC) online within 3 days before arrival.

In accordance to Immigration Act, B.E. 2522

- 2 COMPLETE REGISTRATION**
Key Details Required
Personal Information:
Full name, nationality, phone number,
Email address and passport details
Trip Information:
Flight number, purpose of travel,
and address in Thailand
(e.g., hotel or residential address)
- 3 SUBMISSION**
After completing the form online,
you will receive an acknowledgment email
at the address provided during submission.
- 4 AT THE IMMIGRATION COUNTER**
Present your acknowledgment email
and travel documents
to the immigration officer
upon arrival for verification.



2. If the alien stays in the Kingdom longer than 90 days, he/she must notify in writing the nearest Immigration Officer, concerning place of stay, as soon as possible upon expiration of 90 days. And required to do so every 90 days.
3. Aliens are not allowed to work unless they are granted Work Permit.
4. Foreigners are required to submit their arrival card information 3 days in advance of their arrival date in Thailand.
